# Campaigning

## What is campaigning?

Activities that promote a candidate or a candidate's campaign.

## Who can campaign?

Only nominated candidates may campaign.

## When can campaigning take place?

Campaigning can take place during the campaign period from January 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021.

Campaigning activities must adhere to current public health measures. Please check the Alberta Health Services website for up to date information.

# Campaigning on Election Day and Advance Voting

This is prohibited in and around a voting station on advance voting and Election Day and includes:

- Canvassing for votes
- Displaying signage
- Wearing campaign materials - pins, tshirts, etc.

# Election Signage

## Private property

- Signs can go up during the campaign period
- With permission from the property owner
- If it adheres to related regulations and laws

## Election signs on road-right-of-way

- Allowed from September 13 to October 21, 2021
- If it adheres to Parks and Roads Services Signage Guidelines [Terms and Conditions](#)

## Compliance

- Community Standards & Neighbourhoods Branch manages signage on road-right-of-way
